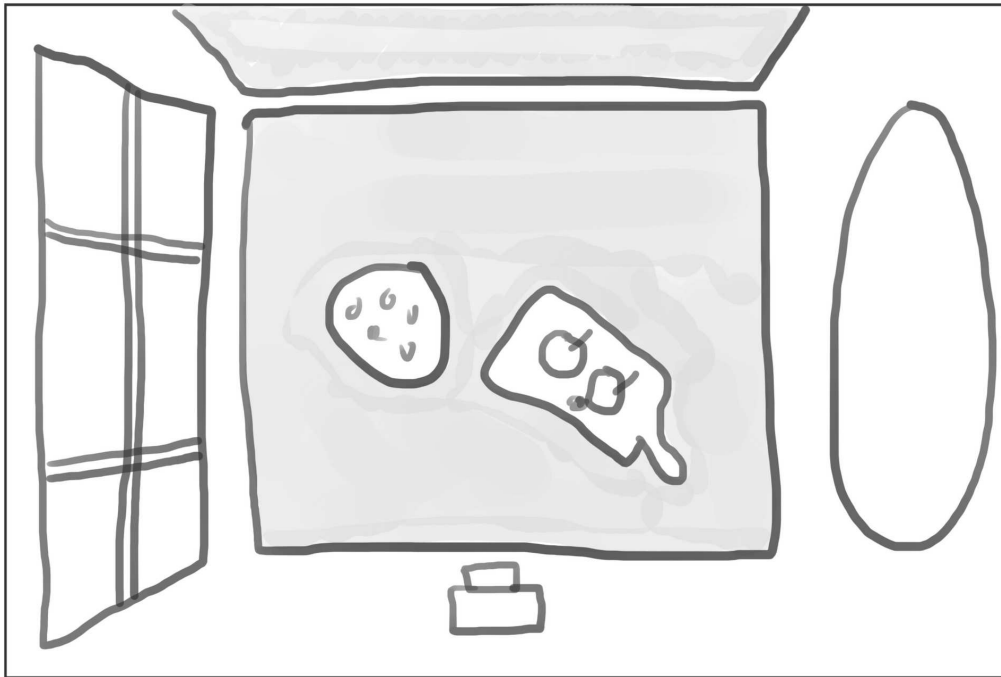


5 top tools for **AWESOME** light for flat lays



1. REFLECTOR
2. GREY CARD
3. REFLECTOR STAND
4. WHITE FOAM CORE
5. WHITE DIFFUSION FABRIC

HOW TO SET UP & USE



- Hang or clip the diffusion fabric over your window.
- Set up your reflector on the reflector stand on the opposite side from your window so that it bounces light back into your set-up. (Silver reflectors give the brightest light).
- Put your grey card in the set-up and take a photo as a white balance reference for your editing.
- Use white foam core underneath and behind your set-up for bright white photos.

FAVOURITE PRODUCTS

These are the five products I use every day to take great product photos and flat lays using natural window light. You can use them too, so that you have bright, light photos for your blog, Instagram, Etsy store and website. Great photos can mean more sales and more income for your blog or business.

If you have great light, you can take awesome photos, even with your iPhone or android phone camera.

WHITE FOAM CORE - available from craft and hobby stores

REFLECTOR - *one that has silver and white sides is most useful.*

REFLECTOR STAND - *many photography brands offer these*

GREY CARD - *from a photographic supplier so it is a genuine neutral colour. Neewer has several; search for 18 per cent grey card.*

DIFFUSION FABRIC - *Neewer nylon silk white seamless diffusion fabric, typically two yards of the 60 inch wide fabric is enough for most windows.*
